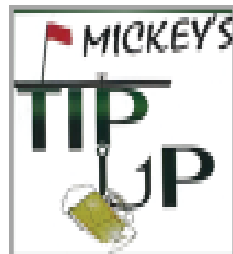

Our deadline to do this is November 1, 2019 so that we can send the majority of memberships in large batches to bypass the club paying processing fees.
