### A Message from our Club... **President**

President's Message... please renew early!!!

Greetings and Happy Fall! Hard to believe we are in to October of 2018 already. With that comes the renewal season for club membership and sponsorships.

I want to take a few lines of space to give an update on the importance of being proactive and timely for renewing your membership now more than ever! In efforts to be good stewards with our resources, the Kellner Knights and the AWSC are trying to find ways to trim cost where possible. The topic for today's message is the processing/transaction fee for online renewals. I think all of us are aware that there is a fee to do a transaction online, we are no different. Even though the online process is easy, convenient, and a great use of time, it does create that extra expense. To help offset that expense, we are going to continue to send your club renewals to the AWSC periodically in batches. The AWSC is charged a fee for every electronic transaction we send them. So, for example, if the AWSC has 40,000 members and each member was renewed individually, the cost would be \$1.50 per member/transaction for a total of \$60,000 for the year. That's \$60,000 not being used by the AWSC to help protect the trails in the state. The AWSC has made a decision to not charge the clubs this fee as it would hurt the clubs. So clubs will work hard to submit as many membership renewals in batches to keep the transaction cost as low as possible.

#### The Process:

For those that don't know how this process works... let me explain. When a club member renews their membership, our volunteer membership chair confirms and sends your info to the AWSC to update you on the roster as renewed! (Remember, the more members at the AWSC level... the more impressive it is to any party the AWSC has to work with to protect our sport.) This step takes a couple of days, so if you were planning to order your annual trail pass right away, there could be a lag as to when you could get the discounted trail pass sent to you. Now we are expecting to collect a few renewals and send them to the AWSC as a batch to create only one processing fee. Early in the season, we feel this is an acceptable step. So, to get included in a batch right away... just renew as soon as you can. As a reminder, renewals with the club can be done online or through the mail.

#### Sponsorships:

Lastly, this pertains to sponsorships. We have had a tremendous out pouring of support by local businesses that have partnered with us... and to that we say THANK YOU!!! We enjoy supporting those that support us and promoting them at all of our events we participate in throughout the entire year (spring, summer, fall and winter.) We run our annual sponsorship renewal at this time also. By getting the business sponsorships renewed, it gives us time to make any additions, updates or changes to all of our social media, newsletters, banners, posters and signage! We want this info current as we begin our season of events for the coming year. All of this chasing and coordinating is done by volunteers, so we have to be able to fit it into our schedules also.

So, the moral of the story is to PLEASE RENEW EARLY!! Sorry to sound like a broken record, but it truly helps with all the administration that has to be done as we prepare for the coming season. ## Here's How to Renew Your Club Membership & Trail Pass Information

We encourage our members to renew their Kellner Knights Club membership soon. It is preferred you do this on-line at <http://kellnerknights.org/join-our-club/> and pay on-line, you do not need a PayPal account to do this. However, if you prefer to mail your membership form and a check to us, you may print out a membership form found on the same link mentioned above. Memberships are entered into the AWSC online membership system. This is done monthly after Kellner Knights club meetings and periodically throughout the snow season based on membership numbers. The AWSC passes on credit card processing fees of \$1.50 PER transaction, so it's important to reduce the number of transaction by sending as many memberships as possible each time. After your club membership is entered into the AWSC system it will take up to 48 BUSINESS hours to process. After processing you can find your AWSC number at <https://www.awsc.org/About-Us/Member-Lookup> and may then apply for your Discounted Annual Trail Pass for the 2019 season through the AWSC website. If you have been a club member before, you retain and use your AWSC number from previous years and you may find that on the WSN magazine label or on the Member Lookup link above.

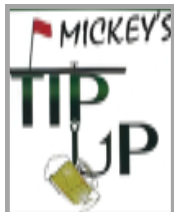
