Snowmobile Safety Course - Dec. 9 & 16



In Wisconsin all persons who are at least 12 years of age and who were born on or after January 1, 1985 are required to take a Wisconsin Approved Snowmobile Safety Course, and obtain a snowmobile safety certificate when riding on public lands. **We are offering a course in Wood County on Monday, December 9 and Monday, December 16 at the Grand Rapids Fire Department from 6-9pm.** It is required to sign up for all safety courses on the DNR Go Wild website [https://](https://gowild.wi.gov/)

gowild.wi.gov/. If this is your first time on the Go Wild website, you will need a DNR Customer ID#. Simply follow the "Get Started" link to do this. Then you may search "Snowmobile" courses in "Wood" county and enroll for our class. *(Our course, however, is not available on this website quite yet and may not be viewable until after November 12th. As soon as they do post it, we will share it on our Facebook page and all members should receive an email if we have their current email address in our system.)* This class is limited to 30 students and they must attend both sessions dates.
