President

Greetings Everyone!

I hope everyone's summer is going well and you are all staying safe! It's hard to believe that snowmobile season is only a couple short months away. I don't know about you, but I am getting the itch!

As we draw closer to fall, it is time once again to remind everyone that you need to renew your snowmobile club memberships. As a reminder, your AWSC memberships expired on June 30, 2020. So, in order to get your discounted trail pass for this season, you will need to renew your memberships now! Renewing your membership is easy. Simply go to our website and click on membership!

Normally during the summer, we would have had one of our biggest fundraisers of the year by hosting Bingo at the Kellner Cornfest. As many of you know, this was cancelled because of COVID-19. In its place this year we had the idea to do a boat parade in conjunction with Anchor Bay. Kellner Knights Club Renewal & Trail Passes Information

Trail passes have been available to purchase since July 1, 2020. We encourage our members to renew their Kellner Knights Club membership by early fall so that you receive your trail pass prior to the trails opening. It is preferred you do this on-line through our webpage at <http://kellnerknights.org/join-our-club/> and pay on-line, however, you may print the membership form found to the right and mail it with your check if you prefer. After you join the club, you may then apply for your 2021 Discounted Annual Trail Pass through the AWSC website. Trail Pass registration and general information may be found on our webpage at <http://kellnerknights.org/trail-pass/> or at www.awsc.org.

Did you know that the fine for riding without a WI Trail Pass is \$250? We hope you pass the word on to fellow snowmobilers and inform them of the need for trail passes. Encourage them to join a club if they do not belong to one already to qualify for the \$10 discounted pass (non-members will pay \$30 per year for their trail pass.) The club discounted Trail Pass receipt will be legal to ride with! The receipt will be good for 3 weeks from the date of purchase. Just remember that the State of WI will continue to send out the trail passes, not the AWSC.
